
Video for Headlines, Assignments, Article Library and Blog

A better solution for attaching videos to module instances. Easy attachment UI for video files and external sources via URLs. Responsive end user view with thumbnail and lightbox design.

Summary

The thumbnail image (poster) should have the same height and width attributes anywhere it is shown on any device. The width should be 320px with a height of 180px. This includes in site manager, when scrubbing to find a thumbnail (poster) image.

For the play icon, use class "bb-icon-triangle_play".

On hover over the image, darken the video behind the white play icon using opacity, and add a 2px white round/circle border around the play icon using border using border-radius property.

If the video was uploaded, no URL should be shown. If a oEmbed video, show URL.

- Clicking on a record title or clicking edit brings up the additional fields screen for editing title and description fields only. Thumbnail can be edited if video was uploaded.
- 2 If video is uploaded, show file size under title.
- If the video was linked through oEmbed, show the oEmbed provider.
- Create a new tab for attachments list.
- 5 The placement of Attachments tab when editing or creating a record.
- If there are no attachments, hide table and show "We noticed that you don't have any attachments. Click Add Attachment to get started."
- 7 For the video icon, use class "icon-attachment_video"






- Uploading File overlay can be seen when uploading a video through the Premium Video App.
- Use standard C2 validation for URL type on field.
- If URL validation passes, check if domain is supported. If not, show critical error in the blank area under the field. <div class='ui-error critical inline'>This video provider isn't supported. Check our list of supported providers.</div> Use the slideDownControl function to show the list of providers in a 3 column list. If domain is supported, check for valid oEmbed response. If not valid, display oEmbed error message in the blank area under the field. <div class='ui-error critical inline'>Video not found. (use the response we get back)</div>
- Only show mp4 files available to be selected.
- Only allow video file uploads up to 500MB. If file is larger than 500MB, show critical error: <div class='uierror critical inline'>This video file is too large. Uploads are limited to 500MB. You may upload your video to YouTube, Vimeo, or any of our other listed providers and then link to the video instead.</div> (use the slideDownControl function to show the list of providers, same as above.)
- ICONS: In the left column, use icon class "icon-ultra-link" for the URL option and "ultra-desktop" for the upload option.



Summary

Show this screen on edit of an attachment, as well as, the second screen of the wizard dialog on creation of new attachment.

Additional Fields




- Dragging the scrub/seek bar shows the current frame with the current position on the bar.

 Working prototype of the thumbnail selector can be found at http://jsfiddle.net/sarahardy/uknmfm3e/. The code might need modified a bit when integrated into product.
- If video is URL, change UA to say "You can change this image from the website where the video is stored." The seek bar should not be shown if URL video is used.
- For files linked by url, only allow edit on title and description (still show thumbnail, but don't allow it to be changed).
- For files that are uploaded, allow edit on title, description, and thumbnail. On edit, set video player for selecting a thumbnail to Attachments->Thumbnail->FrameTime value to show currently selected thumbnail.

Summary

The content associated with the apps and the way that content is displayed at end user is to be kept as existing. For Headlines and Article Library, show video attachments underneath the content in the detailed view only for that record. Blogs show the content directly on the page so the attachements should go directly beneath the main content (posting). Assignments show the detailed view on the same page, but after clicking the assignment title. Thus we will place the attachments under the assignment main content (description) in the detailed view.



- Each thumbnail should be ordered from left to right and stack vertically when multiple attachments are present per record.
- Thumbnail is just an image. OnClick, show hidden video in center of viewport with modal.

If uploaded video, use HTML5 video tag with

With linked videos, show the oEmbed html player.

Attachment Wizard

Options:

ID - ID of the containing div for the element

Label - The label to use for the title of the dialog and for the button to open the dialog

Example: Attach Video, Add Video

Description - The description to display on the dialog under the title, if left blank, default to text using the label

Example: Select a video location then choose your video.

Attachments - The flex data field that will store the attachments ison object value

FileTypes - The list of filetypes (extensions) the wizard will allow

MultiUpload - The boolean value to determine if the Attachment control will allow multiple or single uploads

WizardOptions - The list of options to choose from in the file wizard

ATTACHMENT WIZARD

- New User Control, similar to File Wizard with additional functionality
- Include all properties that File Wizard has with the addition of Label, Description, Attachments, MultiUpload, and WizardOptions
- Upload File:

Limit uploads to a max of 500 Mb

Save File to InstanceAssets location, ModuleInstance/[ModuleInstanceID]/Data/[DataID]

Use Video tag with a custom seeker to select thumbnail, like here. Use a hidden Canvas tag to generate thumbnail.

Store thumbnail image as base64 (retrieved by caling the toDataURL() method on the canvas tag) in Thumbnail property on json object for attachments.

Link Attachments:

Use Oembed Standard http://oembed.com/

Compare url against the cms. Oembed Provider. Domain property when determining if it is one we support.

Replace {url} variable on the cms.OembedProvider.RequestUrl property with the url the user types in the AttachmentWizard control.

Store as an array of json objects in the defined Attatchments field, [\$FieldName\$], i.e. in a hidden field:

Edit File Link:

Open the second dialog screen of the wizard.

Uploaded files (Attachments->Source = "internal") will allow edit for title, description, and thumbnail.

Set video player for selecting a thumbnail to Attachments->Thumbnail->FrameTime value to show currently selected thumbnail.

- Links to files (Attachments->Source = "external") will allow edit for title and description (no edit on thumbnail, but will show thumbnail image).
- AttachmentWizard builder control will render the list, as well as, the dialog.
- Add AttachmentWizard to the Builder Toolbox. Put AttachmentWizard under the category Upload & Wizard
- Adjust ToolboxControls->SWControl to include MultiUpload under the true/false dropdown, add WizardOptions to the array builder tool (with FileTypes option)

ATTACHMENT VIEW

- New User Control (so it can be used in premium apps, as well)
- Parse through json object for each attachment object. Build out html sever-side. Assign Thumbnail value as src. Assign URL value as <video> src.
- Video tag will be displayed in a lightbox.
- For external links, call the oembed endpoint again to get the html to render for the video (html will not be stored in the json object).
- Add AttachmentView to the Builder Toolbox. Put AttachmentView under the category Rich Controls

EXISTING APP ADJUSTMENTS

- Add AttachmentWizard builder control to Site Manager Edit Views for Headlines, Assignments, Article Library and Blog Apps.
- Add AttachmentView builder control to End User Detail Views for Headlines, Assignments, Article Library and Blog Apps.
- Add Attachment Flex Data Field to Headlines, Assignments, Article Library and Blog Apps.

DELETE ATTACHMENTS

- If ModuleInstance is deleted, delete folder and all files under the app instance folder, ModuleInstance/[ModuleInstanceID]
- If FlexRecord or Assignment record is deleted, delete all files under the InstanceAsset folder, ModuleInstance/[ModuleInstanceID]/Data/[DataID].
- If individual record is deleted in the attachment list, just delete that specific file.

Add to Apps:

- Headlines
- Assignments
- Article Library
- Blog

Note: Currently supporting Video file types in this design, but Attachments will later support other file types, as well.

Existing/Shared options will come in a later design. Not necessary for just video.
